



Free Church Youth Camps – COVID-19 Policy

REFUND POLICY

In the event that a 2022 Free Church Youth Camp is cancelled due to COVID-19 we will offer the following options:

- Transfer the booking to an alternative camp if possible
- Donate what you have paid to Free Church Youth Camps
- Full refund to your original payment method

Campers may be unable to attend for various reasons related to COVID-19 including local restrictions, being asked to self-isolate and being symptomatic. If this is the case, we will offer you one of the following:

- Transfer the booking to an alternative camp if possible
- Donate what you have paid to Free Church Youth Camps
- Full refund to your original payment method

MINIMISING RISK

Ensuring the health and well-being of everyone involved in Free Church Youth Camps is our top priority. Our camps will operate under the guidelines provided by the Scottish Government (details available [here](#)). To maintain a healthy and safe environment at camps, all volunteers and campers are required to follow the guidance set out by the Scottish Government. This includes ensuring good hygiene for everyone; maintaining appropriate cleaning regimes; keeping occupied spaces well ventilated; following public health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases of COVID-19. We will ask all centres/activity providers to share with us their COVID-19 policies to ensure adequate mitigations and precautions are in place.

As per Government guidelines we recommend all adults and eligible children and young people take up the offer of a vaccine.

As an appropriate mitigation, it is recommended that all leaders and campers of secondary school age and above take a Lateral Flow Device (LFD) test two days before camp begins (these are free to order from the [Scottish Government website](#)). We would also recommend that leaders and campers of secondary school age and up continue to take the LFD tests regularly throughout the camp.

Please note this policy is subject to change with any new Scottish Government guidelines.
